BAC Resolution No. 2024-2Q-06- 0562

A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE LOWEST CALCULATED RESPONSIVE BID (LCRB) AND RECOMMENDING THE AWARD OF CONTRACT TO MGM MEDICAL SUPPLIES & GENERAL MERCHANDISE FOR THE SUPPLY & DELIVERY OF DRUGS & MEDICINES, CHU AND SMLIK, TABACO CITY UNDER CONTRACT ID NO. 008-04-2024-GOODS-PB

WHEREAS, the Local Government Unit of Tabaco City posted the Invitation to Bid for the *Supply & Delivery of Drugs & Medicines, CHU and SMLIK, Tabaco City under Contract ID No. 008-04-2024-GOODS-PB*, with an Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) amounting to *Three Million Seventy-Five Thousand Eight Hundred Forty-Six Pesos and Twenty-Seven Centavos (Php 3,075,846.27)* in the PhilGEPS website, Tabaco City website and in conspicuous places at the premises of the LGU-Tabaco City continuously for seven (7) days;

WHEREAS, in response to the said posting, four (4) suppliers had shown interest to participate by purchasing the bidding documents;

WHEREAS, during the deadline for submission and opening of bids on April 24, 2024, the BAC received four (4) bid proposal;

WHEREAS, the opening and preliminary examination of bids, using non-discretionary “pass/fail” criteria, resulted as follows, to wit:

WHEREAS, the BAC immediately conducted the detailed evaluation of bid, which resulted as follows, to wit:

WHEREAS, the BAC Technical Working Group (TWG) conducted a post-qualification of *PLC Trading, Inc.*, the bidder with lowest calculated bid, involving the verification and validation of its legal, technical and financial documents;

WHEREAS, however, the bid of *PLC Trading, Inc.*, was found non-compliant and non-responsive to the requirements of the project on the following grounds, to wit:

- 1) Failure to submit the Certificate of Product Registration (CPR) and the Certificate of Good Manufacturing Practice (CGMP) of some items;
- 2) Submission of CPR with inconsistent details as per verification at the FDA verification portal; and
- 3) The validity of the CPR and CGMP of some items were already expired.

WHEREAS, based on the foregoing grounds, *PLC Trading, Inc.* was declared post-disqualified through BAC Resolution No. 2024-2Q-05-0385 dated May 08, 2024;

WHEREAS, the BAC-TWG proceeded with the post-qualification of the bidder with second lowest calculated bid, **Medicatus Pharma Distributor**, involving the verification and validation of its legal, technical and financial documents;

WHEREAS, however, **Medicatus Pharma Distributor** was also found non-compliant and non-responsive to the requirements of the project on the following grounds, to wit:

- 1) Submission of PhilGEPS Registration Certificate with a suspended validity;
- 2) Failure to use the prescribed form of the Omnibus Sworn Statement;
- 3) Failure to submit and comply the post-qualification documents particularly the latest income/business tax returns filed and paid thru the EFPS for the past six months;
- 4) Failure to submit the Certificate of Product Registration (CPR) and the Certificate of Good Manufacturing Practice (CGMP) of some items;
- 5) Submission of CPR with inconsistent details as per verification at the FDA verification portal; and
- 6) The validity of the CPR and CGMP of some items were already expired.


WHEREAS, based on the foregoing grounds, **Medicatus Pharma Distributor** was declared post-disqualified through BAC Resolution No. 2024-2Q-05-0458 dated May 23, 2024;

WHEREAS, the BAC-TWG proceeded with the post-qualification of the bidder with third lowest calculated bid, **MGM Medical Supplies & Gen. Mdse.**, involving the verification and validation of its legal, technical and financial documents. It was found that **MGM Medical Supplies & Gen. Mdse.** is substantially compliant with the requirements of the foregoing procurement and its bid is responsive;


NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing, We, the Members of the Bids and Awards Committee, hereby RESOLVE as it is hereby RESOLVED:

- a) To declare the bid of **MGM Medical Supplies & Gen. Mdse.** as the Lowest Calculated Responsive Bid (LCRB) for the **Supply & Delivery of Drugs & Medicines, CHU and SMLIK, Tabaco City under Contract ID No. 008-04-2024-GOODS-PB**; and
- b) To recommend to the City Mayor of Tabaco the award of contract to **MGM Medical Supplies & Gen. Mdse.** in the amount of **Two Million Nine Hundred Ninety-Four Thousand Nine Hundred Fifty-Six Pesos and Fifty-Four Centavos (Php 2,994,956.54)**.


