Call to Order and Declaration of Quorum

Members, a quorum was declared. BAC Chairman Atty. Coderis presided the conference. The Pre-Bid Conference was called to order at 9:40 in the morning. With the presence of the majority BAC

2. Digest of the Pre-Bid Conference

- . The BAC Secretariat stated the compliance of the BAC with regards to the invitation of observers. It was noted that the observers from TFCCCI, PRRM, and COA who were duly notified and invited for the activity, were not present
- Before proceeding with the discussion, the BAC explained to the prospective bidder present that the pre-bid conference was originally dated on July 09, 2019 as posted in the PhilGEPS. However, due to an important matter to be attended to by the BAC members on the said date, the BAC had issued a notice of postponement and resetting of schedule of pre-bid conference and bid opening and submission. Said notice was duly posted at the PhilGEPS and Tabaco City website on July 04, 2019 as Supplemental Bid Bulletin of the foregoing project. The bidder was advised to secure a copy of the Supplemental Bid Bulletin as it form parts of the Bidding Documents.
- . The BAC presented and discussed the bidding documents of the project. Clarifications/amendments and emphasis were likewise made, as follows:

Audited Financial Statements (AFS), showing, among others, the bidder's total and current assets and liabilities, stamped "received" by the BIR or its duly accredited and authorized institutions, for the preceding calendar year which should not be earlier than two (2) years from the date of bid submission.

The AFS shall be for the year ending December 31, 2018.

Class "B" Documents:

Joint Venture Agreement or duly notarized statements from all the potential joint venture partners, if applicable;

Note: If the bidder is a joint venture or will enter into a Joint Venture, each partner of the JV shall submit the required legal eligibility requirements. For the technical and financial eligibility requirements, any of the joint venture partners may submit and such constitute compliance.

- Technical Documents:
- Bid Security in the form of Bid Securing Declaration (BSD) or any of the other form mentioned in the Bidding Documents. If BSD is used, it must be duly notarized.
- Conformity with the Technical Specifications which includes the following documents, to wit:
- (i) Section VI-Schedule of Requirements
- (ii) Section VI. Technical Specifications
- (iii) Manpower requirements Organizational Chart / List of Manpower involve in the project
- Omnibus Sworn Statement

Note: This should be compliant in substance and in form and duly notarized. For representatives, the statement shall be supported with Special Power of Attorney (SPA) for Sole Proprietorship or Board Resolution/ Secretary's Certificate, for corporation or cooperatives.

For the Financial Component of Bid (2nd Envelope), there is no other instruction from the BAC. Hence, the financial documentary requirements are as stated in Clause 13.1 of Section II- Instruction to Bidders, of the bidding documents, to wit:

- Financial Bid Form should be compliant in substance and in form; each page shall be duly signed by the bidder's representative.
- 2. Price Schedule shall be filled-in in accordance with Clause 15 of the ITB. No column shall be left blank. If no amount is indicated, the bidder should at least put zero (0) or dash (-) signifying that the item is given for free. Otherwise, the bid will be automatically rejected and disqualified. Each page shall be duly signed by the bidder's representative.

Clause 13.2, Clarification: The total bid shall not exceed the total ABC of the project as well as the bid for each item shall also not exceed the allocated budget for each item which is indicated in Section VI-Schedule of Requirements, of the bidding documents.

Clarifications: Forms provided herein shall be strictly used. No alterations shall be made. Otherwise, the bid will be disqualified.	
Amendments: The markings on the bid which was entered in the Forms provided as "Do not open before July 22, 2019, 9:30 AM" shall be amended to "Do not open before July 25, 2019, 9:30 AM" in accordance with the issued and posted bid bulletin on July 4, 2019.	Section VIII-Bidding Forms

- Observe proper marking and sealing of bids. The bidder shall submit 1 Original Bid and 2 Copies of the first and second envelope. Each and every page of the Technical and Financial Bid should be duly signed or initialed by the bidder's authorized person.
- . The bidders were told that the clarifications / amendments made shall form part of the bidding documents and therefore shall be incorporated in their bids. It was clarified that bidders shall be responsible in obtaining supplemental/bid bulletin, if there is any.
- request. The bidder asked if it is possible to remove the instruction that a bid which exceed the per item allocated budget shall be rejected and make the overall ABC as the basis. The BAC told him that the rule cannot be removed as there are four end-user for the project, each with separate budget for their respective purchase
- The bidder also asked if the LGU is allowed to make additional mark up to the price given by the DOH. The BAC said that LGU cannot as the prices in the DPRI are already determined by the DOH and is final.

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It was also clarified to the bidder's representative present that other prospective bidders are still welcome to participate in the bidding and may obtain the bidding documents before the deadline for bid submission.
