You are therefore required to enter into a contract with us within ten (10) calendar days from receipt of this notice.

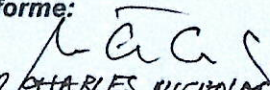

A RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING THE AWARD OF CONTRACT TO BICOL SEEDS GROWERS MULTI-PURPOSE COOPERATIVE FOR THE SUPPLY AND DELIVERY OF WELL-MILLED RICE FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE ASSISTANCE TO INDIGENT HOUSEHOLDS – FOOD ASSISTANCE RICE DISTRIBUTION PROJECT UNDER CONTRACT ID NO. NP-SS-2026-07-0001

WHEREAS, the City Government of Tabaco has an approved project for the Supply and Delivery of Well-Milled Rice for the implementation of the Assistance to Indigent Households – Food Assistance Rice Distribution Project under Contract ID No. NP-SS-2026-07-0001 with an Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) of Twenty-One Million Nine Hundred Ninety-Eight Thousand Four Hundred Pesos (Php 21,998,400.00) chargeable against Trust Fund – Food Assistance/Rice Distribution Project;

WHEREAS, the procurement for the said project is undertaken through Negotiated Procurement – Sagip Saka consistent with Republic Act No. 11321, otherwise known as the Sagip Saka Act, which allows direct negotiation with farmers, fisherfolk cooperatives and associations;

WHEREAS, the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) invited eligible Farmers Cooperatives/Associations and published/posted the Request for Quotation/Proposal for the said project in accordance with the Guidelines for the Procurement of Agricultural and Fishery Products under RA No. 11321 or the “Sagip Saka Act”;

WHEREAS, after the deadline for submission of proposal on **August 28, 2026**, the BAC received two (2) proposals which opening and preliminary evaluation resulted as follows:

WHEREAS, following the receipt and opening of the proposals, the BAC, with the assistance of the Technical Working Group (TWG), conducted a detailed evaluation of the eligibility and technical proposals submitted by each participating Farmer and Fisherfolk Cooperatives and Enterprises (FFCEs), including the verification of the authenticity, completeness, and validity of the submitted documents and the assessment of their capability and capacity to supply and deliver the required agricultural products in accordance with the prescribed specifications, quantities, quality, and delivery requirements, and for the purpose of determining the offer that provides the most advantageous terms to the Government;

WHEREAS, after evaluation and verification, the BAC established the following findings:

WHEREAS, notwithstanding its lower proposed price, the proposal of **Albay Young Farmers Organizations, Inc.** was found **non-compliant** with the requirements of the project due to its failure to sufficiently establish the authority of the person who participated in and/or submitted the proposal on behalf of their organization, particularly in relation to the required Secretary's Certificate, and for failure to sufficiently establish its capacity to supply and deliver the required quantity of well-milled rice in accordance with the prescribed technical and delivery requirements;

WHEREAS, the foregoing deficiencies are materials to the determination of the FFCE's eligibility and responsiveness and cannot be disregarded solely on account of its lower proposed price;

WHEREAS, on the other hand, the proposal of **Bicol Seeds Growers Multi-Purpose Cooperative**, with a proposed price of **Php 21,989,234.00** was found **compliant and responsive** to the applicable documentary requirements of the project;

WHEREAS, the Omnibus Sworn Statement (OSS) submitted by Bicol Seeds Growers Multi-Purpose Cooperative, together with its Secretary's Certificate, sufficiently established the authority of its designated representative to participate in and submit the proposal for and on behalf of the Cooperative;

WHEREAS, **Bicol Seeds Growers Multi-Purpose Cooperative** likewise satisfactorily demonstrated its compliance with the prescribed technical specifications and its capacity to supply and deliver the required well-milled rice in the quantity, quality, and manner prescribed by the Procuring Entity;

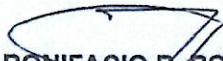
WHEREAS, after considering the foregoing findings, the BAC determined that **Bicol Seeds Growers Multi-Purpose Cooperative** is the responsive FFCE whose proposal provides the most advantageous terms to the Government among the participating FFCEs, at a total proposed contract price of **Php 21,989,234.00**, which is within the approved budget of the Project;

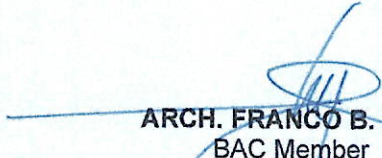
NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises, **WE**, the Members of the Bids and Awards Committee, hereby **RESOLVE**, as it is hereby **RESOLVED**, to:

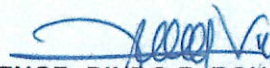
1. **DECLARE** proposal of **Bicol Seeds Growers Multi-Purpose Cooperative** as **responsive and compliant** with the requirements of the project **Supply and Delivery of Well-Milled Rice for the Implementation of the Rice Distribution Project under Contract ID No. NP-SS-2026-07-0001**, undertaken through Negotiated Procurement - SAGIP SAKA; and
2. **DECLARE** the proposal of **Albay Young Farmers Organizations, Inc.** **non-compliant and ineligible for award**, notwithstanding its lower proposed price, on account of the material deficiencies and non-compliance identified by the BAC during the evaluation of its documentary, technical, and capacity-to-deliver requirements;
3. **RECOMMEND** to the **City Mayor of Tabaco**, as the Head of the Procuring Entity (HoPE), the **AWARD OF CONTRACT** to **BICOL SEEDS GROWERS MULTI-PURPOSE COOPERATIVE** for the **Supply and Delivery of Well-Milled Rice for the Implementation of the Assistance to Indigent Households – Food Assistance Rice Distribution Project under Contract ID No. NP-SS-2026-07-0001**, in the total amount of **Twenty-One Million Nine Hundred Eighty-Nine Thousand Two Hundred Thirty-Four Pesos (P21,989,234.00)**; and
4. **RECOMMEND** that the appropriate procurement and contract documents, including the Notice of Award and Contract, be prepared and processed in accordance with the applicable Sagip Saka Guidelines, Republic Act No. 12009 and its Implementing Rules

and Regulations, Republic Act No. 11321 and its IRR, and other applicable government procurement rules and regulations.
